Is the CRT Market Economically Viable?

- Worst commodity market in 6 years
- You can't overpay (or undercharge)
- You can't make it up on volume
- Recyclers must be able to walk away from a bad deal
- Sometimes the best deals are the ones you don't do
- You need to be in the black in each category: services, reuse, and commodities

How do we do it?

Service

• Freight, data destruction, reporting, serial numbers, standards, auditing, and logistics

Reuse/Asset Disposition

• Refurbish, repair, remanufacture

Recycling/Processing for commodities


Steel, aluminum, copper, precious metals, plastic, glass



CRT Glass Processing

- Separate panel and funnel glass
- Clean, crush, and sort by size specification
- Organic contaminant removal
- Maintain inventory volumes
- Sell as raw material substitute

*Certified to R2:2013, ISO 14001, OHSAS 18001



Use as a Raw Material Substitute*

- Ceramics
- Lighting fixtures
- Tiles
- Building materials

*Approved by U.S. EPA







Why not landfilling/retrievable storage?

- Not sustainable, not what we do
- Landfilling/retrievable storage is not recycling
- Most companies and state programs require CRT's to be recycled
- 20 state programs ban landfilling
- R2:2013 does not allow landfilling of focus materials
- Bad precedent for flat panel monitors

CRT Glass Solution

- Recycle the glass!
 - Markets exist, all about costs, not capacity
 - Stockpiling, landfilling/retrievable storage is not recycling
- EPA FAQ
 - Recyclers are aware of what's going on
 - Continued efforts to raise awareness
- Federal and State enforcement is key
 - Product take-back distorts the market
- OEMs, Retailers, Consumers must pay
 - CRT recycling is not free
